Staff will support the BOT by encouraging students to wear these.</li> <li>• As part of the Health curriculum, all students who bus to and from school will receive yearly tuition in bus behaviour and safety from the NZ Police.</li> <li>• Every second year junior students will take place in road safety tuition , in term 1, from the NZ Police.</li> <li>• Parents and caregivers will be requested to deliver/ pick up students from the Church carpark or on Station Street. Parents and caregivers will be encouraged to walk across the road to retrieve their child from the school side, especially if they are young. Reminders of this will be placed regularly in the school newsletter.</li> <li>• All students travelling to events or activities will be by approved bus or car.
